The Wesley Hall entrance has had its locks replaced. If you have a copy of the former key, please be aware that using it to unlock those doors will not work any more.

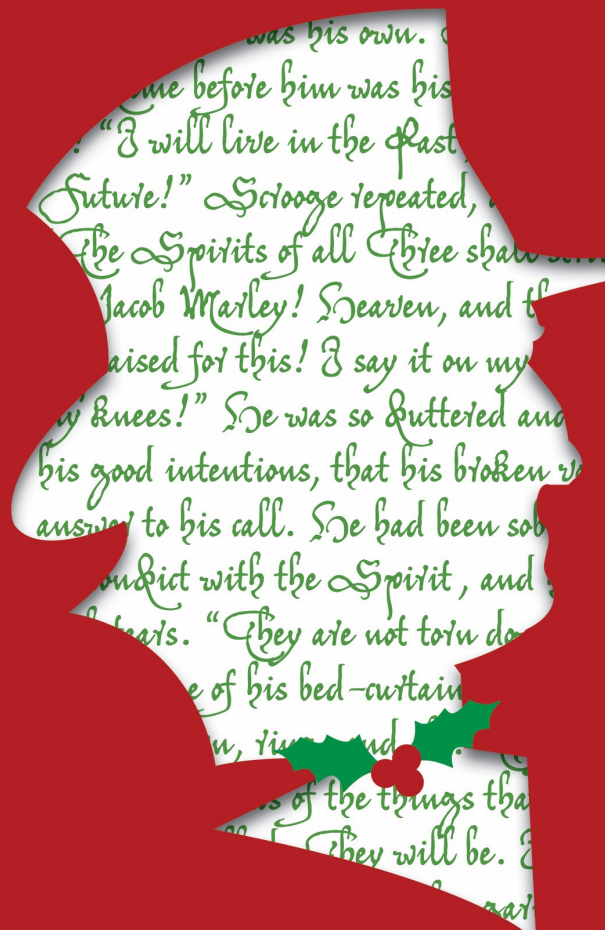
